Nan was working as a visiting professor at the National Astronomical Observatory of Japan in the early 1990s when a bold idea came to him. This was to build a radio telescope 500 meters in diameter to explore the origins of the universe. At the time, the biggest such telescope in China was less than 30 meters across. Giving up his well-paid position at one of the world's top scientific research institutes in Japan, Nar returned to China in 1994 or pursue his "unreachable" dream. (Para.3 P.178)




