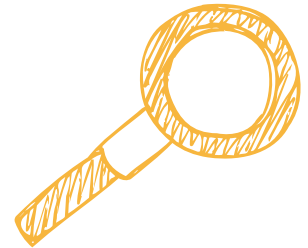


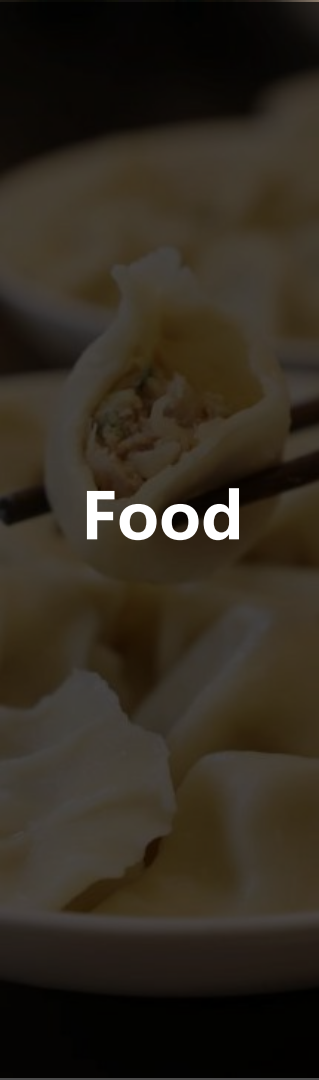
Scenario
