- the duty to relieve others' suffering

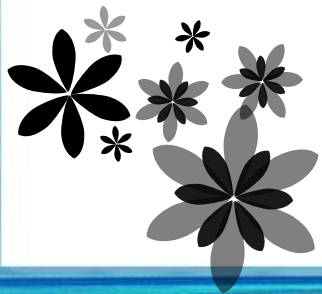
