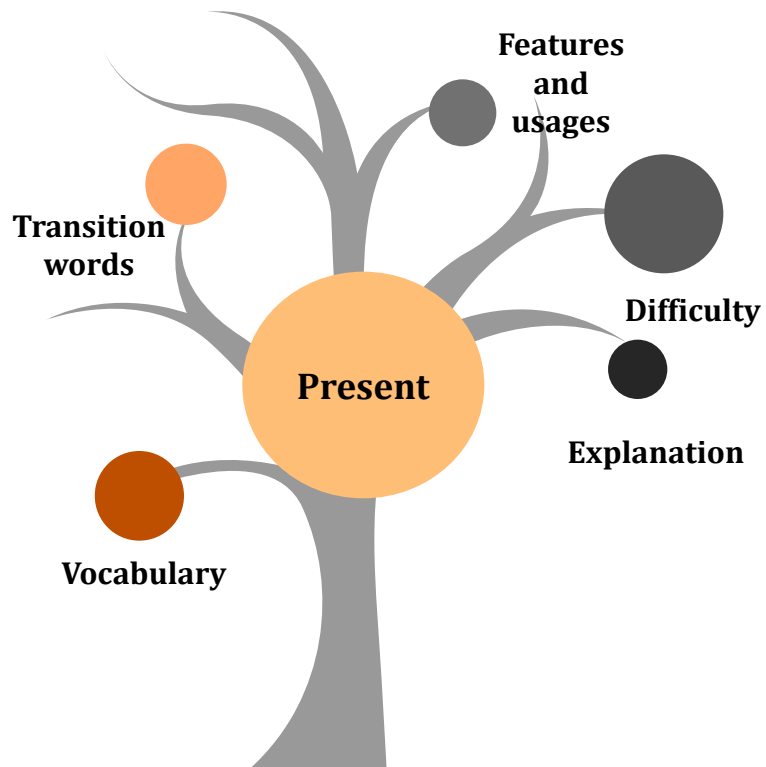

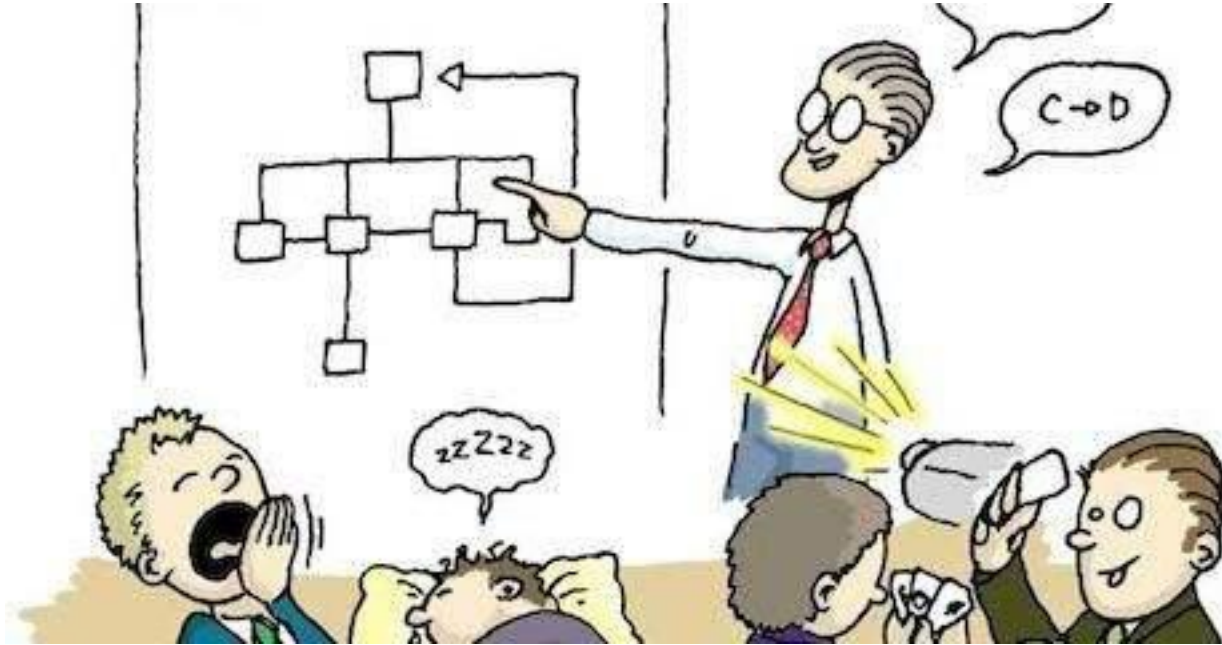

Accurate information

- What** is the issue?
- Why** does it happen?
- Which** is a better solution?

Complete structure

→ **How** should I structure my presentation?

What & why

Issue	Special features in Chinese
Listening	4 tones,
Pronouncing	Special pronunciation in pinyin, e.g. j, q, x
Reading	No space between the words
Writing	Chinese characters are picture originated
Comprehending	Same pinyin with different tones stand for different characters.

Which is a better solution?

Issue	Ways of learning a language
Listening	Drown yourself to swimming
Pronouncing	Shadowing
Reading	Mnemonics (Get familiar with words)
Writing	Scriptorium
Comprehending	Immersion
