


How to Refute

- Structure
 - Opposing argument + granting merits + rebuttal
 - PEEL (point, elaboration, example, link)

Pros and Cons



Pros

- Supporters of legislation legalizing assisted suicide claim that all persons have a moral right to choose freely what they will do with their lives as long as they inflict no harm on others. (Para.3)
- Furthermore, it is argued, we ourselves have an obligation to relieve the suffering of our fellow human beings and to respect their dignity. (Para.4)

Cons

- Those who oppose any measures permitting assisted suicide argue that society has a moral duty to protect and to preserve all life. (Para.5)
- Further, opponents of assisted suicide claim that society has a duty to oppose legislation that poses a threat to the lives of innocent persons. (Para.6)
- Finally, it is argued that sanctioning assisted suicide would violate the rights of others. (Para.7)




A Five-paragraph Format
