



TALK ABOUT CHINA

The Great Wall is one of the world wonders and a UNESCO World Heritage site with a history of over 2,000 years, but it has been experiencing decay. Together with continued restoration efforts, several projects have been started in recent years to protect it with the help of digital technologies. In one of the projects – the Digital Great Wall – 360-degree panoramic photos of the Great Wall have been taken to produce high-precision 3D models and restore its original look.
